Hear More Clearly! We recently upgraded our hearing loop system for worshipers using hearing aids in the Church. If your hearing aid has a telecoil (T-Coil) setting, switch your device to the "T" setting, or connect via your hearing aid phone app. The audio signal from all microphones will be broadcast directly to your hearing aid. If your hearing aid does not have a "T" setting, contact your audiologist and/or hearing aid provider. Compact loop listening devices (which enable you to hear as if you were wearing a hearing aid) are also available upon request from our greeters.

Nursing Mothers' Space - A private space for parents to feed, care for, or calm their babies is available inside the Nursery lobby (look for signage). We hope this space makes Sunday mornings a little easier for you and your baby.
