

Prepare for Your Christmas Eve Worship Pilgrimage

To ensure that everyone has a safe and meaningful experience on Christmas Eve, we encourage you to plan ahead and note these important details:

- Please arrive **early** for your preferred service to allow plenty of time for parking, walking, and finding seats.
- In the spirit of hospitality and courtesy, seats may not be saved for friends or family arriving later.
- Watch for pedestrians and use extra caution in the parking lot.
- Feel free to drop off those with mobility challenges in the Circle before parking your car.
- Care for each other: If you are able, park as far away as possible to allow those with mobility challenges to park closer.
- Wear comfortable shoes!
- Consider using a rideshare service.
- If you normally attend one of the earlier services, consider choosing a later, less crowded one instead.
- If you prefer to worship online, invite friends and family to gather and worship together, and let us know you're watching in the comments section. See broadcast details below.
