



TRIP HIGHLIGHTS

June 11- 20, 2026 *depending on flight availability

Travel as a group from Charlotte to Madrid and back

Walk from Sarria to Santiago, & then to Finisterra (~15-20 miles per day)

Visit sacred churches, plazas, and historical landmarks

Reflect daily through prayer, silence, & conversation; build deep connections with fellow pilgrims

ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Depart from Charlotte as a group & arrive in Madrid, transfer by bus to Sarria, & begin walking the Camino together

Walk over several days toward Santiago de Compostela & then finish at the lighthouse at Finisterra

Overnight stays in local hotels with luggage transported for you & most meals provided







COST

Approx. \$4,000 per participant; a reduced cost is dependent on group fundraising efforts.

Includes international group flights, accommodations, most meals, luggage transfer, Camino guide, & devotional book.

Scholarships are available.

YOUTH ELIGIBILITY


Be an active participant in the life and liturgy of Christ Church

Actively participate in fundraising efforts


